You review and approve production and analytical documentation accompanying the release of API, safety assessment or clinical supply lots (bulk and packaged) to ensure conformance to appropriate regulatory requirements.

In addition, the auditor communicates and resolves audit comments with client areas. Under supervision, or as part of a team, you will perform audits or inspections of assigned areas or systems to assess compliance with regulatory and company standards. You issue reports summarizing deficiencies and work with areas to execute remedial action. Notify appropriate management of inspection result.
